# RULES AND REGULATIONS

## 1. CARING FOR YOUR HORSE:

Please be mindful of the health of your horse. Do not bring horses that are in poor or injured condition. The longest ride of the week will be approximately 30 kms. You and your horse must be capable of completing this distance each day. Rides are conducted at a walking pace with various areas designated (where conditions permit) for you to canter your horse if you wish.

## 2. VETERINARIAN CHECKS:

NB: Horses may be subject to veterinarian checks at the discretion of the committee.  
Horses failing a vet check will not be permitted to participate until cleared by the veterinarian.

*(A veterinary fee may be incurred at your cost)*

## 3. REQUIREMENTS WHEN RIDING:

- a. A Warning Bell will be sounded 15 minutes prior to riding out each day. (Assemble on Southern side of Kitchen)
- b. You will be issued with a Numbered Registration Tag. **(COLOURED GREEN)**  
*"DO NOT SWAP OR LEND YOUR TAG"(Your Issued Tag Number is our quick reference to your personal details in the case of an emergency)*
- c. Your Registration Tag is to be worn prominently on oneself or displayed prominently on your mount.
- d. Every rider must present his/her Numbered Registration Tag to the Gate Attendant before riding through the Exit Gate each day. *(Absolutely No Exceptions)*
- e. Upon return from the daily ride, every rider must again present his/her Numbered Registration Tag to the Gate Attendant. *(No Exceptions unless granted permission from the Trail Boss)*
- f. Persons under the age of eighteen years *Must Wear Helmets.*
- g. Persons under the age of eighteen years are to be supervised at all times by a parent or designated guardian.
- h. Riders to be in charge of only one mount when riding.
- i. Riders must not ride past the designated Lead Rider.
- j. Riders are not to canter off on trail rides unless given permission by the Trail Boss/Lead Riders.
- k. Appropriate Riding Footwear must be worn while riding.
- l. If your horse is a known kicker. Please place a **RED** ribbon in its tail.
- m. Strictly **NO ALCOHOL** permitted on rides.
- n. Please supply your own cup each day for Morning Tea/Lunch.

## 4. REQUIREMENTS WHEN CAMPING AT SHOWGROUND:

- a. Any unsociable and/or offensive behaviour will not be tolerated.
- b. No loud amplified music will be permitted after 10.00 pm.
- c. Campfires will be permitted. *(Subject to Fire Regulations imposed by the NSW RURAL FIRE SERVICE)*
- d. All gates to the Showground must be closed at all times. (Day & night) If you find a gate open, Please close it. This will ensure the containment of runaway horses. *(The horse may well be yours)*
- e. All horses at the showground must be yarded, stabled or tethered when not supervised.
- f. No horses are to be left free to roam about the showgrounds without supervision.
- g. All rubbish to be placed in bins supplied.
- h. All stables and/or yards that you use are to be mucked out prior to departure at the end of the Muster. All horse waste, feed and bedding matter from horses stabled at the showground where possible is to be placed in the designated facility supplied.

5. All riders must obey any lawful command and/or reasonable request from Police, RTA, Representatives of the Weddin Shire Council, Committee person of the Weddin Mountain Muster and/or I&I personnel with reference to Traffic Control and/or Bio Security.
